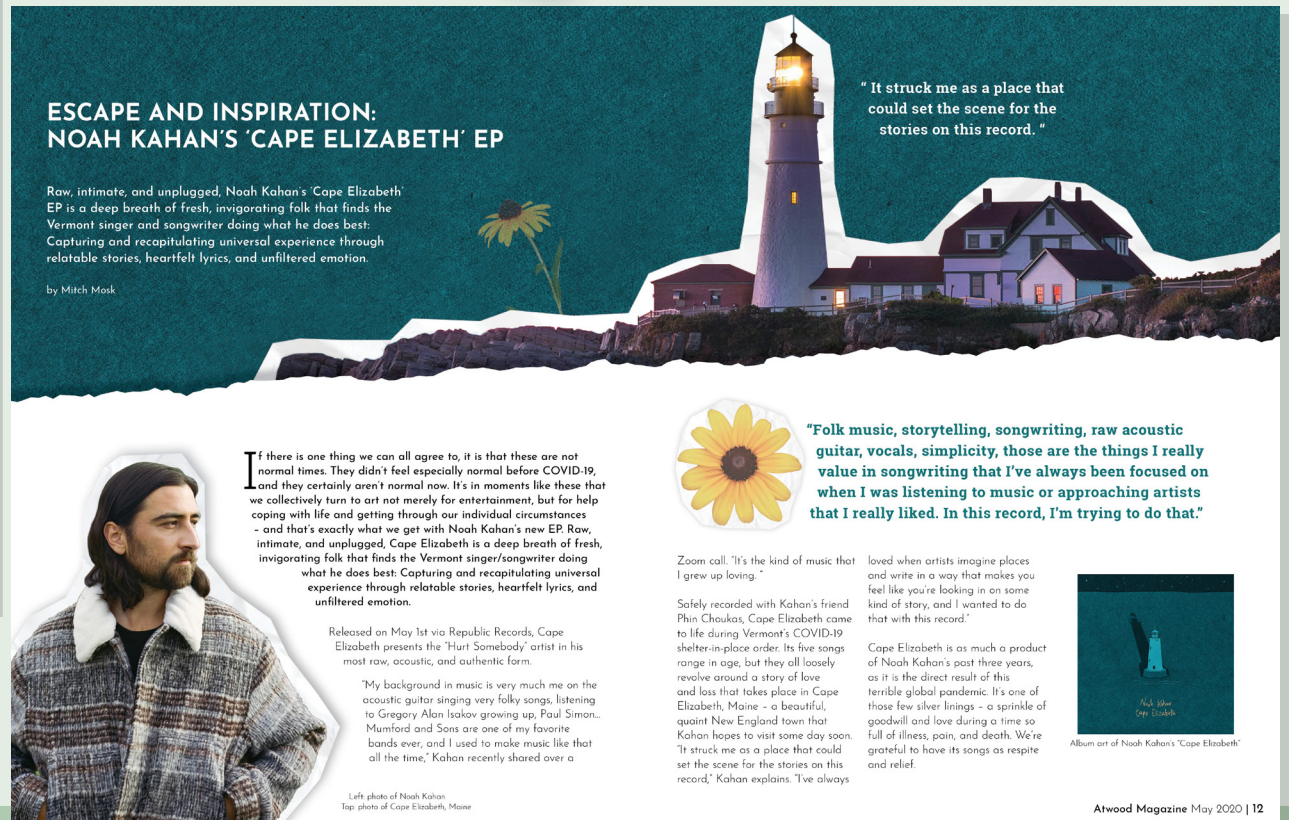
Ad Design (Photoshop, Illustrator)
